With reference to your application dated 11.09.2023 and subsequent correspondence with the School / Inspection in this regard, I Education Officer convey and grant for provisional recognition to, Al-Barkaat Malik Muhammad Islam English School, Vinoba Bhave Nagar, Kurla (W.) Mumbai-400 070. (For C.B.S.E. Board Only) for Class 1st to 8th for a period of three years w.e.f. dt. 01.04.2022 to 31.03.2025.

The above sanction is subject fulfillment of following conditions:-

- 01. The grant for recognition is not extendable and does not in any way imply any obligation to recognized or affiliate beyond class VIII.
- 02. The school shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure I) and the Maharashtra Right of Children to free Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 (Annexure II)

- 03. The School shall admit in Class I, to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighbourhood and provide to them free and compulsory elementary education till its completion, Provided, further that in case of Pre-Primary classes also, this norm shall be followed.
- 04. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as per section 12(2) of the Act. To receive such reimbursements school shall provide a separate bank account.
- 05. The Society/ School shall not collect any capitation free and subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure.
- 06. The School shall not deny admission
 - To any child for lack of age proof.
 - On the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.

07. The School shall ensure:

- (i) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in the school.
- (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment;
- (iii) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education .
- (iv) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 23.
- (v) Students with disabilities/special needs are included as per provision of the Act.
- (vi) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualification as laid under section 23 (1) of the Act. Provided further that the current teachers who, at the commencement of the Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualifications with in a period of 5 years.
- (vii) The teacher performs his or her duties specified under section 24 (1) of the Act and

- (viii) The teachers shall not engage himself or herself for private teaching activities.
- 8. The school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
- 9. The school shall enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the section 19 of the Act.
- 10. The school shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Act. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given under:

- 14. The School is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other person or for any other profit.
